

2018 MINT CROP REPORT

NORTH AMERICAN MINT

The 2018 season was a long, hot one for the Far West United States Peppermint crops. Fortunately, the increased temperatures did not affect the quality or quantity of oils produced from the region. In the Midwest, farmers planted fewer acres of Peppermint, due to aging fields and less oil yield. Some have increased their Native Spearmint acreage, and the Far West Marketing Order recently passed an increase in salable pounds to offset this reduction.

INDIAN PEPPERMINT & CORNMINT

At planting time for Peppermint and Cornmint in Uttar Pradesh province, India, temperatures were around 50° F, which is a favorable condition. During the monsoon season in June and July, conditions were unfavorable for both mints' crops. However, the higher pricing is due to increased demand for mint in international markets.

CHINESE SPEARMINT

Spearmint is grown in the Henan Province, Xinjiang Region, and Shandong Province of China. Roughly 5,500 acres have been planted between the three areas and weather conditions have been favorable.
